The county school board of Loudoun County of seven members cast a unanimous vote to rebuild at Lincoln. What is the weight of this decision?

The financial plan for our schools makes the financing of a new building and the cost of its operation a matter of district cost alone. It has been the custom for the board to defer in most natters except those of the most general nature to the wishes of judgment of the one member in whose district the question arises. The selection of teachers is even decided for the board by one member. On the county board of supervisors when a bridge or road is located one member usually decides for the board and they confirm his wish. It is a known fact that the Mt. Gileal member wanted the school at Lincoln and that he made was special trips to see several members of the board before the meeting when the question was passed upon.
