Additionally, the Superintendent's Record of Teacher Certificates lists both instructors who taught at their respective schools during the 1926-1927 and 1927-1928 terms.*

*Ellen G. Metzger, 1868-1960, (33 years experience in 1927) was an instructor at Leesburg School. She taught at Leesburg during the 1926-1927 and 1927-1928 terms. The certificates record also shows that she taught only part of the 1928-1929 term.*

*Sarah Stickle, 1903-1968, (5 years experience in 1927) was an instructor at Middleburg School through the 1929-1930 term, according to the certificates record.*
