We have just received official notice from the office of the State Department of Education that "in order to participate in the Salary Equalization fund during 1954-55 and 1955-56, a county must expend from local sources for operation (not including capitol outlay and debt service) an amount equivalent to a uniform tax levy of 45¢ per \$100 of true values (1950) of locally taxed wealth. This is a new requirement applicable to this fund."

## The Figures Are -

True Values	
Amount Required for operation \$.0045 times \$99,469,000	447,610.
Total Proposed Expenditures for Operation - Page 2 of Budget	746,005.
State Funds Anticipated Page 2 of Budget	333,250.
Difference equals budget proposal for operation	412,755.
Deficiency	34,855.

The Salary Equalization fund is - - - 30,484.

We shall lose this unless we add \$34,855. from local funds.

We are additionally required to maintain a State Salary Schedule which we could not do without the Salary Equalization Fund.
