To School Board Members:

Please think about the following before the special meeting on the 18th.

1. Save \$40,000 from our budget by discarding the proposal to raise all teachers' salaries \$300 and substitute therefor the following:

A. Apply a salary increase of \$60 per year to all brackets of our two schedules and additionally meet the minimum State require-

ment in certain cases.

B. Raise the salaries of all teachers holding the revived elementary certificate and whose salaries are much below the schedule \$200 to meet a minimum State requirement.

This should save \$39,700 on the basis of present teachers.

- 2. Deduct \$2,000 or \$3,000 from the proposed expenditures for permanent improvements.
- 3. Continue the same number of teachers at Hamilton, Lovettsville, and Purcellville.

Add a teacher at each of the following schools:

Douglass High School

Loudoun County High School

Round Hill School

Conklin (only if necessary to reopen)

This would permit the addition of 2 teachers after schools open.

4. Dispose of the pending question as to whether the 7th grade from Bluemont will continue at Round Will and also whether grades 5 and 6 will be transferred from Bluemont to Round Hill.

See attached salary schedules on which I have indicated in red the new schedule which is proposed.
