We, the citizens of Mountville, hereby petition the School Board of Loudoun County, to erect a new two-room school building for this Community. We hereby pledge our support to this end.

Our present one-room structure, as our Supervisor and Superintendent know, is not suitable to accommodate the children of this Community. Our maximum enrollment is 47 pupils, with an average attendance for this month, of 34, - grades running from one to seven. The present building is a relic of by-gone days, dirty, poorly lighted, leaky, in no way fire-proof or wind-proof and absolutely not equipped to work for the best interests of the children.

We thoroughly appreciate the assistance you gave us this term, when we asked for a second teacher and another room, and the whole Community is very much pleased with the progress the children have made under the present arrangement, and we feel that it will be impossible to go on another year with only one teacher.

The citizens of this Community are showing tremendous interest in getting a new school building for this Community. We have organized a Community League, holding meetings every Tuesday night, and will work untireingly to this end.

We further petition the School Board to maintain our two teachers for the coming term. This is the most important factor, even with the present equipment.
